STUDENT LOANS

Most UK or EU nationals living in England are eligible for a government backed postgraduate student loan.

Postgraduate student loans are paid directly to you, and you can choose how much you borrow (depending on the current maximum loan limit set by the Student Loans Company).

Eligibility is determined by the Student Loans Company. For students living in England,

- being under 60 on the first day of the first academic year of your course
- being a UK or EU national, or have 'settled
- having lived in the UK, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man for 3 years before starting
- not having already obtained a postgraduate degree or taken out a postgraduate student

Can you tell your PG Cert from your MSc? Here's our guide to some of the confusing terms in Higher Education.

Bachelors degree

Also known as an undergraduate, first or honours degree. The most common form of higher education, traditionally taken immediately after A-levels. Bachelors degrees are available in almost any subject and study duration is normally three years full-time or four years part-time, and they consist of 180 credits.

There are a number of different types of Bachelors degrees, including Bachelor of Arts (BA), Bachelor of Science (BSc), Bachelor of Laws (LLB) and more.

Masters degree

Also known as a postgraduate degree. Usually studied after completing an undergraduate degree, however this is not necessarily a requirement. Masters degrees are split into either 'taught' or 'research' degrees, depending on what the majority of study time is devoted to.

There are a number of different types of Masters degrees, including Master of Science (MSc), Master of Laws (LLM), Master of Business Administration (MBA), Master of Business Management (MBM), Master of Public Health (MPH), Master of Education (M.Ed.) and more.

Postgraduate Certificate

Usually shortened to PG Cert, this is a short postgraduate qualification consisting of 60 credits at Level 7 (compared to 180 for a full Masters).

Postgraduate Diploma

Known as a PG Dip, this is another short award that may be achieved by students who pass 120 credits at Level 7.


There are benefits to studying either a PG Cert or PG Dip as standalone qualifications, as they are proportionally cheaper and shorter than a Masters. It is also possible to progress from either short course onto a full degree.

IELTS

The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is the world's most popular English language test for Higher Education. Don't worry if you don't have an IELTS qualification, we will provide a free online English test to assess your English language skills.

TEF

Short for Teaching Excellence and Student Outcomes Framework.
