

ADMISSION AND ENROLMENT PROCESS

HOW TO APPLY

To get admission and enrolment to the selected Master course applicants must comply with IED procedure started by clicking **Apply Online** on ied.edu/master. A dedicated IED Advisor assists applicants through the whole process.

1. Submission of dossier
2. Admission interview
3. Admission confirmation
4. Enrolment confirmation and dossier finalisation

PORTFOLIO

Portfolio is demanded to show candidate's creative aptitude and support the application. The ideal Portfolio must display a single project or a full range of projects presenting all the skills related to design techniques linked with creativity and represented through the use of media design tools.

DEADLINE

To comply with its strict level of quality, and in order to guarantee the effective interaction between teaching staff and participants, IED has a limited number of seats per class. Applicants are strongly suggested to complete the enrolment process at least 3 months before the beginning of the selected course.

ADMISSION CENTER

Thanks to a customized interview with an Admission Advisor and according to personal requests, information will be provided about educational organization, course contents, selection and admission process, as well as professional opportunities.

ACCOMMODATION

Finding a place to live in while planning to study abroad can be both exciting and challenging. IED has agreements with residences and private owners near the schools offering different kinds of rooms.

SOFTWARE

Thanks to the partnership with Adobe and Microsoft IED offers its students a special package including the most used software for designing, such as Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Dreamweaver and the Office suite. Moreover IED students can download for free Autocad softwares such as 3ds Max, AutoCAD, Maya.

FACILITIES

Professional technicians and facility managers are on hand to support students' needs. Available tools include 3D printers, laser cutters, CNC routers; traditional and advanced milling equipment; vinyl high-speed plotters; printmaking equipment for all media; woodworking, sewing and textile production areas; prototyping labs. Photo studios and equipment checkout areas are also accessible, along with a lighting simulation lab and a video "green room".

WORKSHOP

Creative activities based on the combination of conceptual with practical exercises in a short period of time. They allow students to discover new methodologies, to strengthen their teamwork dynamics and to nurture a multidisciplinary approach.

PLACEMENT

IED matches students' portfolios and profiles with the many requests coming from interested companies. The School arranges interviews with freshly graduated students in order to start internships and it provides support to place Alumni in higher positions.
