

ADMISSION AND ENROLMENT PROCESS

HOW TO APPLY

IED Admission process is easy, fast and safe! A dedicated IED Admission Advisor will assist you through the whole process. Choose your course on ied.edu/summer, request information or **Apply Online**, complete your personal information, upload documents, wait for admission confirmation and book your place.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

A high intermediate level of English is required in order to enroll in one of our summer programmes. Level 5.5 IELTS or above is requested. Courses in Spanish require the same level of proficiency.

PORTFOLIO

For Advanced and Professional courses a portfolio may be required.

DEADLINE

Summer admissions close on April 15th. After this date IED does not guarantee access to the course. Check with your Advisor the availability of places.

INTRODUCTORY COURSES

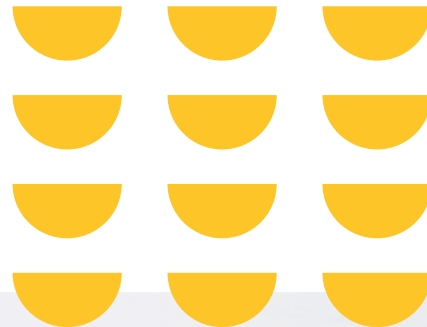
Preparatory courses specifically designed for students with no prior knowledge or experience in the discipline. A good way to transit to a IED Undergraduate course.

ADVANCED COURSES

Designed for students with previous skills or professional expertise in the area of study, and who are interested in developing their professional portfolios through real creative projects.

PROFESSIONAL COURSES

Short modular courses in highly specific topics, designed for professionals willing to go in-depth on a specific theme.

ADMISSION CENTER

Thanks to a customized interview with an Admission Advisor and according to personal requests, information will be provided about educational organization, course contents, selection and admission process, as well as professional opportunities.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT DESK

An office dedicated to the students' integration in the social and cultural background of the city and to the enhancement of their educational experience. This office promotes the communication among students, city institutions and services providers, as well as between students and didactic departments.

ACCOMMODATION

Finding a place to live in while planning to study abroad can be both exciting and challenging. IED has agreements with residences and private owners near the schools offering different kinds of rooms.

SOFTWARES

Thanks to the partnership with Adobe and Microsoft IED offers its students a special package including the most used softwares for designing, such as Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Dreamweaver and the Office suite. Moreover IED students can download for free Autocad softwares such as 3ds Max, AutoCAD, Maya.

SITE VISITS AND FIELD TRIPS

You will complete a great deal of research and group project work outside of the classroom. Each course integrates relevant and rewarding visits to showrooms, studios, galleries and time to meet and speak with industry leaders. Due to the experiential nature of the teaching, class times may change due to company visits, availability of guest speakers or participation in special events.

CREDIT TRANSFER

If you are seeking university credits for the summer course you should contact the international education office at your home institution, find out the transfer credit procedure and have the course work pre-approved by your home university. At the end of the course you may request an official IED transcript that may be used for credit transfer. The IED transcript details the course title, contact hours and teacher evaluation.
