ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES

EAP 100 - EAP 400

Based on an integrated skill curriculum, morning classes will teach you specific strategies to improve your English. Eight language benchmark levels accommodate student progression from a beginner learner with little English skill to advanced language proficiency.



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
